### **MISSION**

International Community Health Services (ICHS) provides culturally and linguistically appropriate health services to the Asian Pacific Islanders and the broader community.

### **SUMMARY**

The primary purpose of the Lead Pharmacist position shall be responsible for providing pharmacy services to patients and medical staff by interpreting and preparing medication orders from health care providers and assuring that all pharmaceuticals dispensed are in accordance with federal, state and department laws and policies.

### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

- Prepare and dispense prescriptions for patients and medical providers.
- Check for accuracy and appropriateness of all medication prescriptions, using information from medication history, patient medical records, and provider inquiry.
- Maintain patient's profile for medication intolerance and/or allergies.
- Check for drug-drug interactions, food-drug interactions and disease-state interactions.
- Assure the appropriate use and storage of pharmaceuticals.
- Perform refill authorization according to prescriptive protocol.
- Perform patient case management upon requests (i.e. mediset filling, chart review).
- Communicate with providers of formulary changes, patient specific prescribing of non-formulary medication, and formulary alternatives.
- Assess appropriateness of medication therapy; identify and suggest resolution to medication related problem; provide consultation and recommendation; document pharmaceutical interventions and track outcomes.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Current Pharmacist license in WA State.
- Bachelors Degree of PharmD from accredited pharmacy degree program.
- Two years progressively responsible and independent work as a licensed pharmacist.
- Experience working in a multilingual/multicultural setting.
- Bilingual in English and Asian language preferred.
